

Abandoned Bamboo Groves P09.10

We manage and protect bamboo forests to prevent the overgrowth and disorder of unused bamboo and trees. Products made from such natural, unused materials are sold nationwide, contributing to forest conservation by reducing waste of forest resources.



Products Using Unused Materials P09.10

By utilizing materials that would otherwise go to waste, we contribute to forest conservation. These materials are crafted into tableware and other products, promoting the concept of "reducing waste by reusing what can be reused."



Development of Reusable Natural Material Products P11.12

We have increased the durability of natural materials by applying natural resin for food-safe processing. This reduces the environmental impact by enabling the reuse of bamboo-derived products and minimizing resource consumption. This concept helps prevent excessive harvesting of forest resources.



Sale of Beeswax & Oil (Organic)

We have developed beeswax and oil products made with safe Japanese ingredients, which are safe for children and pets. Beeswax acts as a natural waterproofing agent, while oil is used as a finishing agent. These products are eco-friendly and can be safely used on wooden products.



Work Assignments for Welfare Facilities

Since 2006, we have outsourced part of our processing work to local social welfare facilities, providing employment opportunities to people with disabilities. We work with organizations like the "Social Welfare Corporation Taiyo no Ie."



Collaboration with Environmental Conservation NPOs

We collaborate with environmental conservation NPOs to conduct ecological surveys and study the condition of abandoned bamboo forests. We also exhibit educational materials at the Kitakyushu Environment Museum to raise awareness about environmental conservation.

The **Unused Wood & Abandoned Bamboo Project** addresses the underutilization of abandoned bamboo and wood, aiming to prevent resource waste and control bamboo spread. Through this initiative, **eco-friendly products** are developed and sold, leveraging these materials. The project seeks to involve more people in forest maintenance, tackling labor shortages while promoting sustainable practices to link natural resource use with environmental conservation.

Bamboo Charcoal Powder (Domestic)

An effective use of unused bamboo material.

A natural food additive bamboo charcoal powder. This bamboo charcoal is made by burning Japanese bamboo at high temperatures and then grinding it into an ultra-fine powder using a new milling process called "gasmill." The particles are extremely fine, tasteless, and odorless, making it suitable as a food additive for various applications. Japanese-made, from Kyushu



Fine Particles (5 Microns)

Made in Japan (Kyushu), with a commitment to being pesticide-free. The bamboo used contains no pesticides, agricultural chemicals, or chemical fertilizers, providing a safe and reliable bamboo charcoal powder as a processed food product.


Takebito Super Coating (TSC) is a high-durability coating applied to products to extend their lifespan. The coating, made from glass and plant-derived alcohol, creates a crystalline polymer film on the product's surface, enhancing durability. This method allows for prolonged use of natural materials, while retaining their original appearance. TSC-treated products are safe for food use and maintain quality for over 20 years.

(Note: No synthetic resins are used in this process.)



Traditional Coating Process


Coating Method Using Polyurethane or Resin



The traditional coating method creates a protective layer by applying coating material on the surface to prevent moisture and dirt from entering the internal fibers of the material. However, this conventional method, where the coating remains on the surface, can deteriorate over time, leading to peeling and loss of protective effects. Additionally, the coating can easily swell and deform, making the appearance uneven as it wears.

Processing with TSC

A process that coats the space around the internal fibers with liquid glass, which is then heated and fixed.



TSC processing improves the durability of natural materials while preserving the spaces between the fibers. This minimizes issues like swelling and odor on the surface, allowing the material's original texture and scent to remain. Additionally, unlike traditional coatings, it prevents surface damage or deformation over time.

Tableware coated with special bamboo charcoal powder paint received a utility model registration in March 2019 as "tableware painted with bamboo charcoal powder-containing paint."
A utility model refers to the creation of technical ideas that utilize natural laws.

In addition, this fine bamboo charcoal is not only used for tableware but also developed for products closely related to daily life, such as safe and secure health foods and cosmetic soaps that utilize the natural scrubbing and absorption effects of bamboo charcoal powder.

A sturdy material made from bamboo that enables carbon neutrality

Bamboo laminated wood is a material created by compressing bamboo fibers to form a solid board. It is highly resistant to warping and cracking and has stable durability, making it ideal for long-term use in items like housewares and furniture.

Moreover, this eco-friendly material contributes to carbon neutrality. Studies show that **bamboo absorbs 70% more CO₂ than trees of the same weight**. While trees can take 40–60 years to mature and be ready for use, bamboo can be harvested in just three years, making it a sustainable material that doesn't exhaust the environment.




Bamboo Composite Material for Housewares and OS&E

Bamboo composite material offers an elegant, luxurious appearance with excellent durability, showing minimal warping and shrinkage. Its hardness makes it resistant to scratches and dents, while its ease of processing allows for high design quality without compromising strength. This material is well-regarded for use in hotel OS&E and housewares.

Carbon neutrality refers to balancing greenhouse gas emissions with absorption. The characteristic of carbon neutrality in bamboo products is their significantly faster growth rate compared to trees.

Yamashita Kogei, based in Beppu City, Oita Prefecture, primarily handles charming ceramics from Kyushu, including Koishiwara ware and Onta ware, as well as other regional ceramics.

We actively export ceramics and glass products from various regions of Japan to international markets.

Bamboo products



Bamboo reaches about 15 meters in 60 to 80 days.

Bamboo spreads by extending underground roots, allowing it to sprout new shoots and expand rapidly. This often leads to forests being invaded by bamboo growth, especially in areas of Kyushu where bamboo is strong and invasive.

Uncontrolled bamboo growth can cause ecological disruption.

Yamashita Kogei actively develops products that utilize bamboo from these overgrown areas, **aiming to promote responsible use and sustainability**. Through this approach, we hope to help more people appreciate the natural charm of bamboo and to foster long-term, enjoyable usage of this sustainable material.

Wood products



Forests absorb carbon dioxide (CO₂) through photosynthesis. However, simply allowing forests to exist without intervention does not contribute effectively to preventing global warming. It is necessary to manage forests actively to ensure they remain healthy and capable of absorbing CO₂.

The forests recognized by the Kyoto Protocol are not untouched natural forests but rather well-managed, **"suitable forests"** maintained through human intervention.

Yamashita Kogei actively uses wood materials in our products to contribute to sustainable practices.




Position as a Manufacturer Vendor (Position as a producer with responsibility)




